

# **Safety Precautions**

- 1. Before use, read all instructions and check the appliance and components.
- Always use your appliance from a power outlet of the voltage marked on the appliance.
- This appliance needs to be used with an air compressor and an air compressor filter.
- 4. Before use, make sure the air pipes are moisture-free.
- Do not use this appliance for purpose other than coffee bean sorting. Incorrect operations may damage the appliance.
- 6. Do not operate until the touch panel is securely installed or locked in place.
- 7. Recommended for use on a stable platform at a height of 80 cm.
- The appliance is heavy, please exercise caution when handling and moving for safety.
- 9. Keep clear of the cooling fan. Allow 10 cm of space from the wall.
- 10. Keep the children away from using the appliance.
- 11. Grasp the plug when plugging or unplugging, avoid pulling on the power cord.
- 12. Do not immerse the appliance into water or any liquid to avoid electric shock.
- 13. Do not use the appliance if the power cord or the appliance itself is broken.
- 14. Do not dissemble the appliance by yourself. Please contact avercasso technician, dealer or any other certificated technicians to conduct maintenance.
- 15. Turn the power off and remove the plug when the appliance is not in use and before cleaning.



This logo is intended to alert the users to the presence of un-insulated "dangerous voltage" within the product's enclosure that may be of sufficient magnitude to constitute a risk of electric shock to persons.



Before connecting the circuit and neutral, the protective conductor (PE) should be connected to the main protective grounding terminal first to avoid the risk of electric shock. 





# **Get Started**

## Installation


1. Secure the touch panel onto the screen support.




Connect the USB cable, HDMI cable and power cable to the touch panel.




- Connect oil-water separator to the air compressor and the air pressure outlet. Plug in the air compressor power cable. Use a pipe wider than 8 mm for the machine air pressure outlet.
- 4. Check if the air pressure display shows around 6-8 kg/cm² (85~113 psi). Plug in the machine power cable, and turn the Power Switch to ON to power up.





# Set up Your CS One

1. For first-time setup, follow the on-screen instruction to set up the system and the sorting module.




- 2. From the Home page (a) > Sorting Module Database (b), select and tap a sorting module from the Module Name list to apply a sorting module as needed.
- 3. Go back to the Home page > tap the **Start** button to start the sorting process.
- 4. To stop the sorting process, tap the **Pause** button **II** to pause, or tap the **Stop** button to end the sorting process.
- 5. When the sorting process is finished, go to **Coffee Bean Sorting History Report** to check the results.
- 6. To power off the appliance, tap the Power button  ${\bf 0}$  on the Home page to turn off the sorting system. For more information, please refer to <Al Sorting System> chapter.
- 7. When the sorting system is off, turn the Power Switch to OFF to power off the appliance.



# **Cleaning and Maintenance**

- For optimal performance, clean the bean hopper and sorting chute regularly after sorting. Use an air gun to clean the dust collector and the recognition module.
- Use a cleaning brush to clean the recognition module.



#### Important:

- 1. Do not immerse the appliance into water or any liquid to avoid electric shock.
- 2. Avoid using abrasives or steel scrubbers.
- 3. When cleaning with an air gun, avoid nozzle contact with the recognition module glass to prevent glass breakage.
- 4. Install accessories only after thorough drying after cleaning.

# First-time Setup



#### **Setup Wizard**

- 1. Select a system language.
- 2. Verify the licensing agreement and the privacy policy.
- 3. Set up the region and time zone.
- Name your device for easy identification when connecting to other devices. Use uppercase and lowercase and numbers. No spaces or special symbols.
- 5. Set up a 4-digit password.



#### Setup a Sorting Module

- Go to Sorting Module Database
- Select and tap a sorting module from the Module Name list to apply a sorting module as needed.

## The Sorting Process



- 1. Make sure to connect your appliance to Wi-Fi. If you see on the status bar at the top of the screen, tap the icon and follow the on-screen instruction to establish a Wi-Fi connection.
- Tap the Date and Time on the status bar to configure date and time.
- 3. From the Home page (1) > Sorting Module Database (2)



- 4. Tap the desired sorting module and confirm.
- To check the applied sorting module, go to Sorting Module Database. There will be a check by the applied sorting module.



- When you see a blue light on the status bar, your appliance is ready to sort the beans.
- 7. Back to the Home page and tap the **Start** button ▶ to begin the sorting process.



- 8. Follow the on-screen instruction to enter a sorting weight. You can check the operation rate on the Home page ( ).
- 9. To pause the sorting process, tap the Pause button **II**.
- 10. To end the sorting process, tap the Stop button ■.
- 11. When the sorting process is completed, go to Coffee Bean Sorting History Report to check the sorting results.

# **Add Sorting Modules**



#### Add Sorting Modules

- 1. From the Home page , go to Sorting Module Database .
- Select Online Update or USB Download.
  - Online Update: The system will search for suitable modules through Wi-Fi connection.
  - USB Download: Download new modules from USB if necessary.
- 3. A red dot indicates an available update.

## **Coffee Bean Sorting History Report**



#### **View Sorting History Report**

Go to Coffee Bean Sorting History Report (b) to view all the sorting results.

**Note**: If the space is running out, the system will automatically delete the oldest history report to free up space.

#### **Export CSV**

Tap **EXPORT CSV** to export the sorting history report.

#### **Export Defective Bean Images**


- 1. Connect USB to the USB input.
- 2. Tap Export Defective Bean Images.

#### **Delete History Report**

- 1. Tap the Trash can button . The defective bean images of the report will be deleted at the same time.
- 2. Tap **DELETE ALL** to delete all history report.



### **Sorter Cleaning Settings**



Tap **Manual Cleaning of Dirty Lenses**, and follow the on-screen instruction.

### **Issue Report**



Tap **REPORT** to upload the analysis report of the machine for troubleshooting.

#### **Sorter Information**



View software version, module version and machine information.

#### Add CS One

- Make sure your smartphone and your appliance are connected to the same Wi-Fi network.
- 2. Open the avercasso App.
- 3. For first-time setup, tap **Add Device** on the Home page
- 4. Scan the QR Code on the appliance touch panel. (Go to System Settings \( \sqrt{O} \rightarrow \) > Parameter Settings > App Connection Settings)
- 5. View all the added appliances in the Al Coffee Bean Sorter List.
  - Green : Online
    - Grey : Offline
  - The avercasso App will remember the added appliances and detect if the appliances are online.
- 6. Tap the device on the list to view the sorting details.



#### Delete the Paired CS One

- Long press on the appliance that you want to delete in the AI
   Coffee Bean Sorter List.
- 2. Tap Delete > Confirm.



#### Delete the Online CS One

- Select and tap the online appliance that you want to delete in the AI Coffee Bean Sorter List.
- Scroll through the Operation Information card and tap Delete Sorter.

# **Check and Filter Exception Notification**



## **View Exception Notification**

- 1. Go to Notification  $\triangle$ .
- 2. Tap the right arrow on the exception notification to view error details, and follow the error description to solve the problem.
- 3. A red dot indicates the unread exception notification.



### **Set Sorting Condition**

- 1. Go to Notification  $\triangle$ .
- 2. Tap the filter icon  $\sqrt{\phantom{a}}$  on the top right corner to filter notifications based on the appliances or the date.
  - Tap the right arrow of **Select "Query sorter"** to select appliances.
  - Tap Start time and End time to set query interval.



#### Q: Why is the sorting speed so slow?


#### A:

- Follow the on-screen instruction when you see a warning pop-up shows: "Bean stuck in the putter."
- Check and clean the bean hopper if it is stuck.




#### Q: Why is there no display on the touch panel?

**A:** Please check if you connected the USB, HDMI and DC Cable of the touch panel.



#### Q: Why hasn't the defective beans been ejected?


**A:** The air pressure input should be around 6-8 kg/cm<sup>2</sup> (85~113 psi). Please check the air pressure display.



# Q: Why does the machine frequently enter cleaning mode so?


#### A:

- Please check and clean the dust collector.
- If you've already cleaned the dust collector but the problem is not solved, please contact us.



# Q: Why is the CS One sorting accuracy decreasing?

**A**: Please check the air compressor oil-water separator, and drain the air compressor regularly.
